

Halloween Match ~ How to Play


1. Make a set of all Halloween pictures and all word cards.
2. Using six or twelve pairs at a time, place the cards facing away in a numbered pocket chart.
3. Player 1 selects two cards by number. e.g. **un et cinq**. The player must match the Halloween image and the name. e.g. **le zombie**
4. If the cards match, the player keeps the pair. If not, the cards go back in the pocket chart.
5. Player 2 selects two cards by number and must make a match to keep the cards.
6. The player with more pairs at the end of the game is the winner.
7. Another version would use two sets of picture cards or two sets of word cards. A blank card may be used as a free match in the game.




Picture Sudoku - Student

- 3) each large square (group of nine or three by three).






Halloween Sudoku - Professeur
